Wellbeing Coffee Morning-Tuesday 28th June 2022

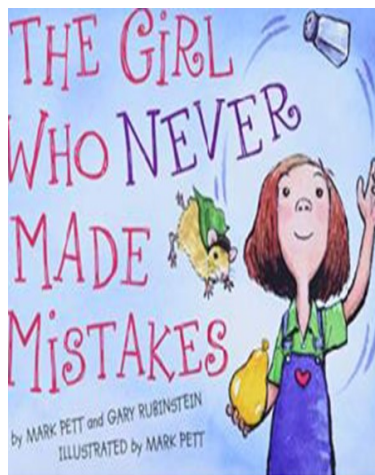
